Our Residency Areas →

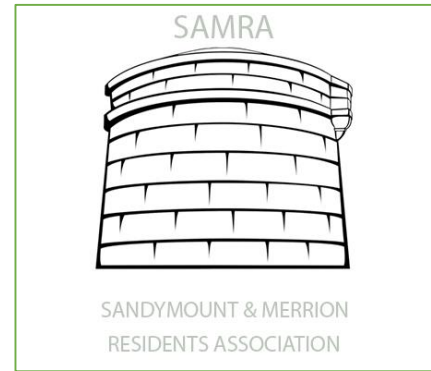

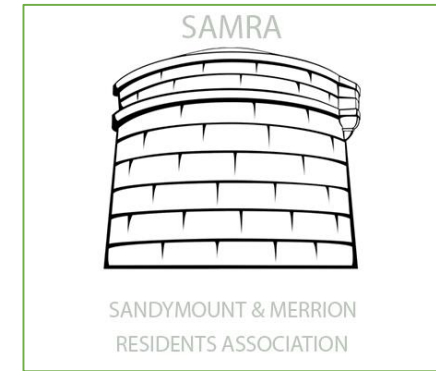


SAMRA : AIMS
