Dear Mr Turner,

I refer to your letters of 19 August and 1 September 2020 in relation to the proposal to develop a two-way cycle track on Strand Road. I regret the delay in responding to your letter of 19 August.

The position in relation to the two issues you have raised is as follows;

1. I can confirm that the option with a two-way cycle track on Strand Road and with one general traffic lane out of town is the only option being considered.
2. I can also confirm that detailed traffic modelling work is being undertaken. This is complicated by the fact that the modelling is based on pre-COVID traffic levels, which are below current levels. A series of mitigation measures have been proposed as part of the public consultation process. The impact of these measures is also being modelled. A comprehensive modelling report will be put on the Consultation Hub as soon as it is completed. The consultation deadline of 14 September will be extended if necessary to facilitate public consideration on the modelling report.

I trust this is satisfactory.
